



As from 25 May 2018, the new General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) issued by the European Union is in force. The GDPR determines how companies must handle the personal data and privacy of individuals within the EU.

Your privacy is very important to us, which is why we would like to inform you of our privacy policy by means of this Privacy Statement.

This privacy statement may be modified occasionally, for example to accommodate legislative amendments. We therefore advise you to regularly check the statement.

Privacy Statement

Van Gool Elburg may process personal data concerning you because you make use of Van Gool Elburg's services.

Van Gool Elburg may process the following personal data:

- Your first and last name;
- Your address details;
- Your telephone number;
- Your IP address.

Van Gool Elburg gathers personal data for several objectives. These will be explained below.

- **Sending newsletters**
Van Gool Elburg sends newsletters by email. These newsletters are commercial on the one hand and informational on the other. Your name and email address are gathered. You may also be asked verbally or in writing to subscribe. Should you prefer to no longer receive these newsletters we ask you to notify us by sending an email to info@vangoolelburg.com. The newsletters are sent with Mailchimp. At the moment you subscribe to the newsletter, your email address and first name are saved to the appropriate list within Mailchimp.
- **Getting in touch**
Van Gool Elburg processes your personal data in order to contact you by telephone if you request this, and/or to write you (by email and/or by post).
- **Contract for services**
Van Gool Elburg may use your personal data in the context of the execution of the contract for services concluded with you.



All data is only processed with your explicit permission. Van Gool Elburg will only supply your details to third parties if this is required for the execution of a contract with you, or to comply with a statutory obligation.

Google Analytics

Van Gool Elburg makes use of Google Analytics to track how visitors use the website in order to determine which parts of the website are most interesting to our visitors.

Google uses this information to keep track of how our website is used and to provide reports about the website to Van Gool Elburg. We use cookies, tags/beacons and JavaScript in order to recognise the browser and thus measure the number of visitors viewing our websites. The statistics and other reports cannot be traced back to individuals.

Google may supply this information to third parties if Google is legally required to do so, or where such third parties process the information on Google's behalf. Van Gool Elburg has no influence on this.

We use cookies, tags/beacons and JavaScript to:

- keep track of the number of visitors on our web pages
- keep track of the time spent on our web pages by each visitor
- keep track of the order in which a visitor views the different pages of our website
- determine which parts of our website need to be modified to optimise the website



Cookies

- Van Gool Elburg makes use of **functional Cookies** to ensure that the website works properly. The Cookies are used for the purpose of:
 - detecting misuse of our website and services;
 - evening the load on the website to ensure that the website stays accessible.
- Van Gool Elburg makes use of **analytical Cookies** to improve usability of the website. The cookies can be used to make private web analyses and optimise websites. The information gathered with the help of these cookies can be used to create statistics. These statistics provide insight into how often the web pages are visited and on which pages visitors spend the most time. The 'analytical cookies' are used to:
 - keep track of the number of visitors on our web pages
 - keep track of the time spent on our web pages by each visitor
 - keep track of the order in which a visitor views the different pages of our website
 - determine which parts of our website need to be modified to optimise the website

Security

The personal data handled by Van Gool Elburg is protected with a password and two-step verification where possible.

This two-step verification consists of a code, which is generated by the software and sent to Van Gool Elburg. This code is then used during the login process by Van Gool Elburg's staff members.

Furthermore, your visit to our website is secured with an SSL Certificate. This means that your connection with the Van Gool Elburg website is private. You can recognise this protection by the green padlock in front of the URL.

Your rights

Right to inspection

You have the right to inspect the data concerning you recorded and stored by Van Gool Elburg at all times.

Right to rectification

If your data is not correct or has been changed, you have the right to have it rectified.

Right to transfer

Should you need the data stored by Van Gool Elburg in case you move to a different party or service, you have the right to transfer. Van Gool Elburg must then transfer all your data to the other party.

Right to delete data

Should you no longer wish that your data is stored by Van Gool Elburg, you have the right to have this data deleted.

Right to file a complaint

Should you be of the opinion that Van Gool Elburg has not handled your data correctly, you have the right to file a complaint with the Dutch Data Protection Authority.

Right to stop use of data

You have the right to stop the use of your personal data.

**Storage period of personal data**

Van Gool Elburg does not store your personal data any longer than needed to achieve the objectives for which your details were gathered.
